West Open 2007

The West of Scotland Open took place at Holyrood Sports Centre, Glasgow over the weekend of 20-21 January. Now established as the premier tournament in the Scottish calendar, it attracted a large international entry and produced many exciting matches over the two days of competition.



Ryan Jenkins (Wales) retained the men's singles title and has now won four men's titles in a row. In a high quality final, Ryan was made to work hard for his 6 set victory against Scottish Number 1 Gavin Rumgay. Earlier, in the semi-finals, Ryan and Gavin came through against Scottish and Welsh Number 3s Niall Cameron and Stephen Jenkins respectively.

Gavin made an excellent start in the final with some very impressive third ball attacks and took the first 11-6. Ryan then got into his stride and won the next two ends 9 and 6. The large crowd was really enjoying a very open and entertaining final. Gavin replied strongly with some tenacious play and took the fourth 11-8 but Ryan was not to be denied and with very impressive counter attacking from both wings, he eventually out manoeuvred Gavin 8 and 6 in the final two ends.

The ladies final brought together Hartlepool based Chinese Junior girls Xu Shu-Ying (Katie) and Lui Meihan (Maria).



In the semi finals Xu Shu-Ying accounted for Scottish Number 4 Corrina Whitaker and Lui Meihan came through against Laure Bordanneau from France. In the final Xu Shu-Ying gave a master class in attack against defence and won in four straight sets against her Chinese compatriot.
